

Parkwood Park Committee
October, 2011

The Parkwood Park Committee did not meet in October.

Below is an update on outstanding action items and recent activities.

1. Invasive Plant Removal and Path Update

Saturday, October 1 work day was attended by 20 volunteers. We tackled three main projects:

Mulched paths around the park.

Removed debris along the curbs

Removed small invasive trees and cut up branches on fallen trees in the park

We will plan another work day in November to complete the removal and clean up of fallen trees and invasive trees and large shrubs. We will add another layer of mulch to the paths.

Planted fescue grass seed along perimeter of the park.

2. West Ponce de Leon Project

The letter to the neighborhood is completed. The planting plan is updated and both will be distributed with the membership form during the membership drive.

The Committee will evaluate the planting plan and make a recommendation to the board the best way to implement the plan based on funds raised during the membership drive.

Karna contacted the Fire Dept and for \$23 per month and \$2.50 per 1000 gallons of water we can rent a water meter to connect to the fire hydrant.

3. E Lake Traffic Circle

Sheri contacted Dennis Begner with Above the Hedges for a written estimate to place the boulders. Camille recommended Dennis for the project. Project installation is tentatively scheduled for early November. Dennis will install the boulders and tree.

Anyone interested in shopping for plants or boulders can contact Sheri.

If it rains next week, we will send out a neighborhood wide email that anyone can remove the remaining plants from the traffic circle. Any remaining plants will be removed at the end of October. Any remaining plants may be donated.
