I. Budget (Steve)

III. 2016 Budget and Fundraising

DHCA is awarding a \$1000 grant for the creating of the Parkwood Meadow, Phase 2.

IV. By-pass Project

The last plant order is in and if it ever stops raining will be planted along the W Parkwood side of the bypass. Once the plants are mulched, the remaining mulch will be used for the new section of the W Parkwood trail.

V. Maintenance

- Weeding and invasive plant removal (Sheri)
- Planted the bypass plants ordered from Trees Atlanta (Sheri)
- Weeded and pruned plants in traffic circle (Sheri)

Scheduled for November

- Plant daffodils in traffic triangle
- Move plants along W Ponce de Leon to other areas of the park
- Spread mulch along the ByPass and W Parkwood trail
- Complete the bypass planting
- Taro removal—-hopefully before first frost
